School Progress

- Elementary Doug Zimmerman
 - CDA and Summit churches hosted Education Sabbaths during which 3 students shared the sermon.
 - Outdoor school for 5th and 6th at Mivoden went very well.
 - Washington DC trip was excellent.
 - Muffins with Moms went well and will be a tradition each year along with Donuts for Dads in December.
 - Accreditation Highlights LCA had the least number of recommendations of all 15 schools they have visited this year. We have 6 years with an interim visit at 3 years which is the best that we can get.

• UCA @ LCA – PJ Deming

- Goal is to work on fixing some of the issues that came up during the pilot program beginning years.
- There was a parent meeting with a question-and-answer session which highlighted some of the areas that need adjustment moving forward in the program.
- At UCA, core classes have been moved to be primarily in the morning and early afternoon, leaving classes like band, choir, etc. later in the afternoon
- The intention of the UCA @ LCA program is integration on the LCA campus and what that looks like moving forward
- Recommended to have a small group of parents and admin gather thoughts together about how to integrate the students onto campus at LCA and make it a desirable opportunity for the students. LCA needs to facilitate that integration with the support of parents and UCA administration
 - Principal and UCA Liaison to come up with a schedule of how the students can integrate into the classroom and bring a proposal to the board in June.
- Enrollment Summary Lana Brauer
 - o Enrollment for 2021-22 is currently 183 students.
 - o Enrollment for next year is at 195 students and growing.
 - With tuition agreements due end of May and first tuition payments due June 10 (non-refundable) this elicits commitment from parents which helps ensure that we are not left with empty classroom desks at the beginning of the school year from families that saved a spot in class then chose not to attend.

Subcommittee Updates
 Finance Committee – Alexander Nickolatos

- Change in financial awards for next school year due to a TADS error. The amount of financial aid awarded has changed from \$11,650.00 for four families to \$17,130.00 for five families.
 - Voted to approve \$17, 130.00 for financial aid for five families.
 - Voted to rescind the previous vote for financial aid of \$11,650.00 for four families from the April 2022 minutes.
- Voted to move forward with 2 classrooms and the elevator with a not to exceed clause of \$277,065.72 with the knowledge that if building costs rise the finance committee and board will need to discuss raising the funds to finish those projects.
- Voted to use the unallocated funds received until the end of June 2022 to pay down the debt.
- Development Tim Windemuth
 - Gym floor being refinished in June 2022
 - Voted to let the marketing team determine the new sports team's name for LCA and present it at the June 2022 meeting.
- Jonathan shared that this is his last year on the school board. Recommending that Shannon Payne become the board chair and that Rick Hervig become vice chair.
